Ward 04 Briefing - 002

[Spaces for People](#) will provide temporary walking and cycling infrastructure across the city to protect public health during COVID-19, by enabling safe physical distancing for essential journeys and exercise, in particular where there are space constraints or user safety concerns.

Providing short-term additional public space is also key to support business operation and recovery in both the city centre and at neighbourhood hubs by enabling safer access to shops and business premises, and the provision of queuing space.

Longer term, and once restrictions begin to ease, it is anticipated that walking and cycling will continue to be considered a safe and convenient mode of transport that benefits wellbeing and air quality.

Location:	Paisley Road West - between Hillington Road South & Lamington Road
Expected Work Start Date:	Monday 13 July
Expected Work Completion Date:	Monday 20 July
Measure(s):	<p>Paisley Road West: north side of carriageway within existing parking layby (directly opposite the Shell Garage) will be removed (estimated distance of 42 metres).</p> <p>Paisley Road West: north side of carriageway will be narrowed by approximately 2 metres between Moulin Road and Lamington Road, for an estimated distance of 33 metres.</p> <p>Paisley Road West: south side of carriageway will be narrowed by 2 metres from its junction with Moulin Road, eastwards for an estimated distance of 37 metres.</p> <p>All parking bays to be suspended.</p>
Purpose:	<p>To allow the widening of the existing footways to enable physical distancing.</p> <p>To allow queueing areas at local shops.</p>
Detail:	The temporary works will be in place for a minimum period of 10 weeks.

	The temporary works will be reviewed in line with the Scottish Government's Covid-19 Framework for Decision Making 'Scotland's Route Map through and out of the crisis'.
